Who Are We?

The Metro District was formed under Colorado law in 1961 and is the largest wastewater treatment agency in the Rocky Mountain West. The District provides wholesale wastewater transmission and treatment service to 59 local governments, including cities, sanitation districts, and water and sanitation districts. They, in turn, provide retail wastewater service to about 1.7 million people in a 715 square-mile service area that includes Arvada, Aurora, Denver, Lakewood, Thornton, part of Westminster, and more than 40 sanitation districts.
