Public Notice of Proposed Amendments to the Metro Water Recovery's *Rules and Regulations Governing the Operation, Use, and Services of the System* Section 6.

The Clean Water Act established the National Pretreatment Program to control the discharge of toxic and/or hazardous waste into sanitary sewer systems operated by Publicly Owned Treatment Works. Under designation from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Metro Water Recovery has been given the responsibility of applying and enforcing the pretreatment standards for industrial users in its service area.

Pursuant to the requirements of the EPA and Metro Water Recovery's desire to provide opportunities for public participation, this notice advises interested parties that a portion of the changes to Metro Water Recovery's *Rules and Regulations Governing the Operation, Use, and Services of the System* Section 6 shall be considered during the December 21, 2021 meeting of its Board of Directors where public comment may be heard.
